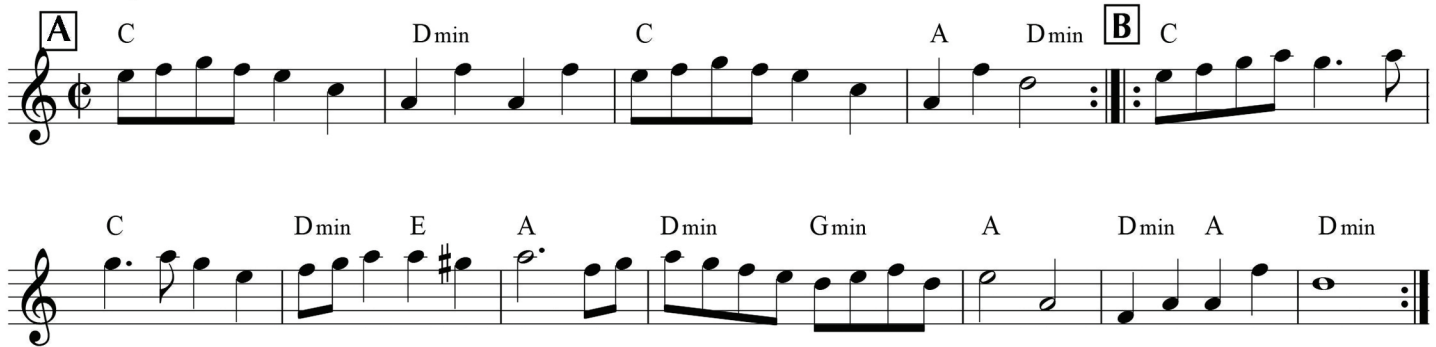


Gene's Tambourine
